



9 LINE MEDIVAC REQUEST FOR PREPPERS

1. Location of pick up:

This could be grid coordinates or code names for predetermined locations.

Examples:

Alpha: 4th and Main St.

Bravo: Old Water Tower South of Town

Charlie: Denny's Restaurant Parking Lot

Delta: The Covered Bridge on 44 Hwy North of Town.

2. Radio Frequency / Call Sign of person at pickup.

Example: Channel 3 (174.32 Megahertz) / Foxtrot 4.

This is given so that the medivac team will know what radio frequency the team they are meeting will be on and the Call Sign of the leader who they will be meeting at the pick up location.

3. Number of patients (also called pax) and urgency of Pick up:

Urgency Example:

Alpha: Urgent (30 mins or less)

Bravo: Priority (Hour or less)

Charlie: Routine (2 hours or less)

Delta: Convenience (4 to 8 hours)

Example: 3 Pax / Bravo.

4. Special Equipment:

This is any special equipment that the medivac team may need to bring with them to the pick up location.

Examples:

Alpha: None

Bravo: Litter

Charlie: Vehicle extraction equipment

Delta: Oxygen

Echo: Fluids

5. Patients by Type:

Meaning what condition for self transportation is each patient?

Examples:

Lima: Litter

Alpha: Ambulatory

Hotel: Need Help walking

6. Security at the Extraction Point:

Meaning how safe is it at the pickup location? Will the Medivac team need to be armed? Will they need a security element to escort them? etc.

Examples:

November: No enemy
Papa: Possible enemy
Lima: Light Enemy
X Ray: Heavy Enemy Presence, Large Armed Escort Required

7. Method of Marking Extraction Point:

This is placing or activating a signal at the pickup location so that the Medivac team will know they are at the right location.

Examples:

Alpha: Colored signal panels
Bravo: Road/Aerial Flare
Charlie: Smoke grenade
Delta: None
Echo: IR Light/strobe/ Flashlight.

8. Patient status:

Meaning what is the hostility status of the persons who are being picked up for treatment? Are they team members, friends, unknown, or enemy prisoners.

Examples:

Tango: Team member
Foxtrot: Friendly
Uniform: Unknown
Hotel: Enemy Prisoner

9. Description of terrain.

Meaning what is a basic description of the pick up location.

Examples (spoken as plain language in bullet points):

- Wooded area
- Rocky hills
- Lake to the south.

Example Transmission:

Bobcat 1 this is Tiger 2, Prepare to receive 9 line:

1. Location Delta
2. Channel 3 / call sign Tiger 4
3. 3 pax, Priority Bravo
4. 1 Bravo / 1 Echo
5. 1 Lima / 2 Alpha
6. Papa
7. Echo
8. 2 Tango / 1 Foxtrot
9. Open field / Pond to the South.

Have them Repeat it back to you for verification.
